VHA is part of the Naloxone Distribution Project working to make life-saving Naloxone (NARCAN) available throughout our community.

If an overdose occurs, here's what to do:

- 1. Try to wake the person
- 2. Call 911
- 3. Give the first dose of Naloxone
- 4. Check for breathing
- 5. Be prepared to give a second dose
